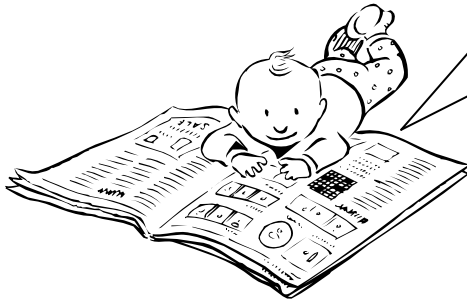




Exciting Research Opportunity!!!

Children ages 5-12 are invited to participate in a language study!!

(Children must be native speakers of English)

Your child will receive a number of complimentary **formal speech and language evaluations** and the results will be made available to you.

During each session your child will be asked to listen to sentences/words/sounds and press a button corresponding to some pictures.

These sessions will be conducted at one of two sites (depending on individual needs) and scheduled at your convenience:
The Cognitive Neuroscience Laboratory at SDSU on Alvarado Rd.
OR
The Language and Cognitive Neurosciences Lab at UCSD in La Jolla
(Travel expenses will be compensated)

This research, approved by SDSU, UCSD and Children’s Hospital’s Internal Review Boards (SDSU# 1423, UCSD #071481, CHCC# 11066) will help investigators better understand how children process spoken language.
