International Experience: All SLHS majors are required to participate in an international experience to increase awareness of cross-cultural issues, global health, economic, political, cultural, social services, and health challenges experienced by local populations in international environments. Students participate in residence for two or more weeks (exemption from the study abroad portion of the requirement must be approved by the dean of the college based on serious and compelling life events or physical limitations; a relevant course and community service activity in the U.S. will be substituted). Transfer Students: Please use www.assist.org to find the equivalent community college or junior college courses that will transfer to SDSU. Transfer students must have an overall 2.75 GPA in order to apply to SDSU and declare the SLHS major.

- (2) **Completion** of a minimum of 60 semester units
- (3) Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75
